WHEREAS, an election on the question of formation of the Ochoco West Water and Sanitary Authority was held on November 4, 2008, and such formation was approved by a majority of voters; and

WHEREAS, also at the November 4, 2008 general election, votes were cast for the Authority's initial governing board; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to ORS 198.820(1), upon voter approval of the formation the Court is required to canvass the votes for members of the board and cause the county clerk to issue certificates of election to the number of persons, equal to the number of board members named in the petition for formation, receiving the highest number of votes; and

WHEREAS, the petition for formation of the Authority named a governing board of seven members, and at the November 4 election the following seven individuals received the highest number of votes:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. The Crook County Court hereby canvasses the vote for the election of the initial board of directors for the Ochoco West Water and Sanitary Authority, and declares the above-named individuals as the first duly elected governing board of the Authority.
2. The County Clerk is hereby directed to issue certificates of election to the above-named individuals, as required by ORS 198.820(1).


